

## Setting up IMAP on your iPhone

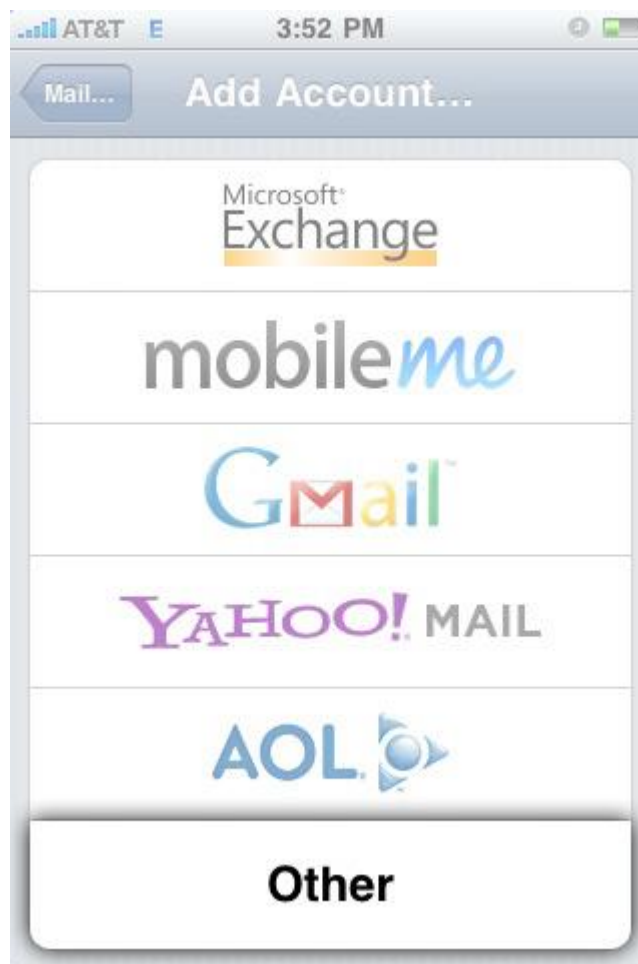
### First time setting up email on an iPhone

#### Step 1

From the Home Screen, choose "Settings"

Next, tap Mail, Contacts, Calendars

From within the "Add Account" section, choose "Other".



**Step 2**

**Click "Add Mail Account"**





### Step 3

#### Enter your Email account information:

Name: Use your name.

Address: [it@expressdata.co.th](mailto:it@expressdata.co.th) ( Your Email )

Password: xxxxxx

Description: This will auto-fill with your address.

Once you have entered your information, press the "Save" button.



#### Step 4

#### Enter the Mail Server information:

Use the following for both the Incoming and Outgoing Mail Server

Host Name: mail.expressdata.co.th ( mail."your domain name" )

User Name: [it@expressdata.co.th](mailto:it@expressdata.co.th) ( your e-mail )

Password : xxxxxx

Once you have entered your information, press the "Save" button.
