

## First time setting backup e-mail on zimbra mail server.

- 1 Go to Zimbra Webmail. (<http://mail.expressdata.co.th>)
- 2 Login by your username and password.
- 3 Go to menu "Preference"
- 4 Go to menu "Account"
- 5 Select Button "Add External Account" and enter your information at External Account Settings.

Your Back up E-Mail window should look something like this.
